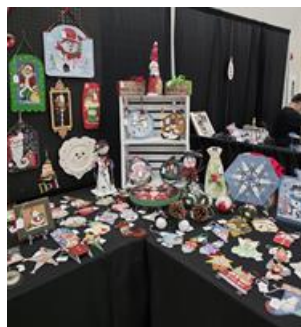


FUNDRAISERS

RECIPE

Corn Casserole Bev brought to the Christmas party.

- 1 can whole corn, drained
- 1 can cream corn
- 8 oz package Jiffy Corn Muffin Mix
- 1 cup sour cream
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup melted butter
- Shredded Cheddar Cheese

Bake 350 for 40-45 minutes

In large bowl, stir together 2 cans of corn, corn muffin mix, sour cream and butter. Pour into greased 9 x 13 pan. Bake until golden brown. Remove from oven, top with cheese and return to oven for 5 to 10 minutes until cheese is melted.
